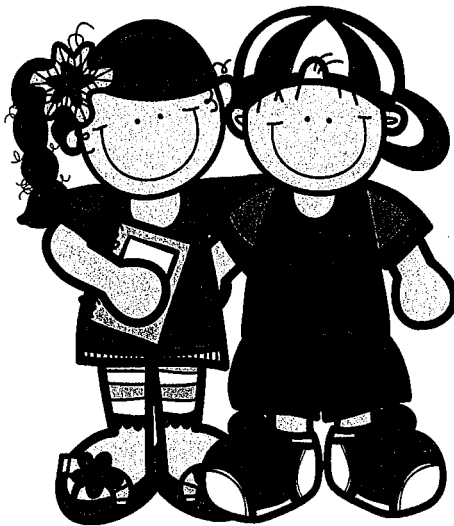

### **Stafford Recreation Hours**

9am – 12pm – Morning Park Program

12pm – 1pm – Lunch

1pm – 4pm – Afternoon Park Hours

In the past, we have had children dropped off or picked up at times that are not listed above.

We ask that you please respect these times as we cannot be responsible for any children dropped off or picked up outside of our hours of operation. Our morning time is used to prepare for the day, and many of our staff members have other commitments after park hours that they need to remain obligated to. Thank you!

## Lunch Program

We are once again offering a lunch program for those children who need to stay at the park through the lunch hour. Lunches will be provided by the Trading Post, at \$4.00 per child per day.

The lunch options are similar to last year's choices, but hot dogs are no longer available:

- Grilled Cheese \* Chicken Nuggets & Fries \* Pizza \* Ham or Turkey Sandwich.
- All lunches will come with chips (except for chicken nuggets), fruit or vegetable (will change daily), and juice or water.
- **No lunch orders will be taken after 10:00 AM. Also, there will be no substitutions.**

We do need to know who will be staying at the park for lunch. If your child/children will be staying on a regular basis, please fill out the bottom of this page and return it to us at the park. If your child/children will be staying sporadically, just send a note in on the day they will be staying. You can of course pack a lunch and bring that too.

The lunch order has to be at the Trading Post by 10:00 AM so they have ample time to prepare and still handle their daily lunch rush. So please, **be sure to come and place your order as soon as you get to the park.** Lunches for the park must be ordered through us. Per the Trading Post's request, please do not call them and add to our lunch order.

### T-Shirts

We will be using the new T-Shirts this summer! Remember, it is required that all children wear a **CURRENT** Stafford Rec T-shirt when attending any of our field trips. Shirts may be purchased for \$3.00 each, and must be purchased prior to the field trip.

### Field Trips

We are very excited about the trips that we have planned for this summer. Each trip will be outlined with their accompanying permission slip located in the back of this packet. Permission slips **must** be turned in by their due date, and any received after that will not be accepted. **ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS!** This is because a proper headcount is necessary to ensure our reservation and to make sure we have the proper accommodations for bussing. In addition, all trips must be paid for in cash. We can no longer accept checks. We apologize for any inconveniences. In order to go on our field trips, attendance to daily recreation is required. Your child must be present at minimum to two days of recreation prior to that week's trip unless otherwise notified to Jamie or Chrissy. For example, we are going on a trip on July 26<sup>th</sup>. This means that the week before this trip, the 18<sup>th</sup> – 22<sup>nd</sup>, your child must be in attendance two whole days of rec (or majority of the day).

### Toys and Electronic Devices

In the past, we have seen many cell phones, I-Pods, game systems, and other expensive items become lost or damaged. Toys get left behind, electronics get left in the sun or rain, not to mention act as a source of disagreement for the kids, and then we are left with an incredibly upset child/group. We understand the love that the children have for these items, but we have a fun-packed summer planned and they won't be necessary. Therefore, due to the unnecessary stress and heartbreak, **WE INSIST THAT ALL OUTSIDE ITEMS BE LEFT AT HOME**, no matter how much they are adored by their owners. They are ultimately a distracting burden on the program, and will be confiscated until the child goes home.

### Leaving the Park

Our hours at the park are 9 – 12, and 1 – 4. If you come to the morning session, and leave prior to noon, we do not expect to see you back until one. Likewise, if you come to the afternoon session, and leave before 4pm, we will see you the next morning. Unless you are leaving for a medical appointment, there is no returning to the park during a session. There will be no riding bikes down to the Trading Post to grab a drink, and then coming back. We cannot be responsible for children coming and going as they please. Also, if you leave for the lunch break, please do not return to the park until 1pm.

### Instructional Sports

This summer, our staff has taken it upon themselves to teach our children the fundamentals of select sports and help them develop the skills necessary to play the games they love. Our goal is to get the kids involved in active participation with one another, learning to function as a team and enjoy one another's company. Instructions will be held by counselors in the morning, while games corresponding to the lessons will be held during the afternoon. **Please send your children with shoes if participating.**

### Ice Cream

The past few years we have been taking ice cream orders and picking up various treats from the Stafford Trading Post in the afternoons. We will continue with this afternoon treat again this year! This year we will have more options available, and all choices will be \$1.00.

### Penny Carnival

As we have every year, we will again be having our Penny Carnival. This year it will be on Tuesday, August 2<sup>nd</sup> and will last the whole day. There will be plenty of games, face painting, music, snacks, and prizes. All of the money raised between the two will be donated to a local charity.

### Bonfire

On Thursday, August 11<sup>th</sup>, we will be having our annual end of summer bash at the park. The party will start at 5:00pm (please, no sooner) and will end around 8:00pm. At the party, we will be giving out many of our awards from over the summer, as well as announce Mister and Miss Stafford. We will, of course, have a ton of food, piñatas, and music all night long. It is always a fun way to wrap up the summer. **Please note: there will be no recreation at all this day to allow staff to full prepare for the bonfire. There will be recreation only in the morning on Friday, August 12<sup>th</sup>.**

**Breakfast at Recreation/Special Persons Day**

On Friday, July 29th, Stafford Recreation will be hosting our annual Breakfast at Recreation/Grandparents and Special Persons Day. In order to ensure that we have enough food, we ask that you fill out the form below so that we have an idea of how much we need to get. Even if you won't be having anyone join us, please send this back in. We will also be doing a craft with our special persons as well, so everyone come ready to be creative!

**\*\*We will also be combining this day with our Historical Society Trip!** In the afternoon, we will be walking to the Town Hall to visit the Stafford Museum and learn about the history of the Town of Stafford. Grandparents are welcome to accompany your grandchildren on this trip! We will be having lunch at our normal time, and departing to go to the Town Hall around 1:00. Grandparents may take/drive their grandchildren.

# Stafford Summer Recreation Discipline Agreement

## As a participant I promise:

Not to destroy, harm or damage park equipment, property, etc.

Not to use any vulgar language.

To always use good sportsmanship.

To adhere to decisions made by the supervisor and staff members.

To respect myself and other participants in the program.

## As a parent/guardian:

I understand that while my child/children are participating in the recreation program, the recreation supervisor and staff are in charge and participants are required to follow the rules set forth by the staff. However, I agree that if any difficulties or disagreements arise, I will address my grievances to either the Recreation Supervisor; Jamie Turman (585) 356-9019 and/or Recreation Director Renee Price (585) 356-0989.

If any rules are broken, the following procedure will be enforced:

**1<sup>st</sup> infraction – Warning**

**2<sup>nd</sup> infraction – Time Out**

**3<sup>rd</sup> infraction – Cannot attend park the following day**

**4<sup>th</sup> infraction – Cannot attend park for one week**

**5<sup>th</sup> infraction – Cannot attend park program for the remainder of the summer**

At 3 infractions, the parent/guardian will be notified of the problem.

**ABSOLUTELY NO BULLYING TOLERATED. If a child, or group of children, is/are found to be behaving maliciously or disrespectfully towards another child, these children will be either suspended for a week or asked to leave the program indefinitely, depending on the severity of the infraction.**

The goal of the program is to make each child responsible for his or her own actions, and ensure the physical and emotional well-being of those who choose to join us for the summer.

I have read the Discipline Agreement and Policy with my child/children. I understand that while my child/children are attending the recreation program, whether at the park or on field trips, the Recreation Supervisor and staff are in charge. Participants are required to follow the rules set forth by the staff. ### **Archery**

This summer we will again be having a few sessions of archery for our children to practice and learn about. This was something that last year the children truly enjoyed, so we are excited to be bringing this program back again this summer!

### **YMCA Swimming at the Stafford Country Club**

Once again this summer, the Stafford Country Club, in conjunction with the YMCA will be allowing us to use their pool on Mondays throughout the summer. We will be doing two sessions every Monday, the first from 1:15 – 2:15 and the second from 2:30 – 3:30. Each group will be walking from Emery Park to the SCC using the trail behind the park. The cost of swimming will be \$5.00 per child per visit. As this program is run through the YMCA and not the Country Club, even those children whose parents are members are required to pay. We are only allowed 10 children per session, so we will operate on a first come-first served basis. In the event that we have less than 10 children total, we will only go to the earlier session. Please fill out and return the appropriate permission slip on the day your child(ren) will be coming to the pool with us. (The pool is of course, weather permitting.)
