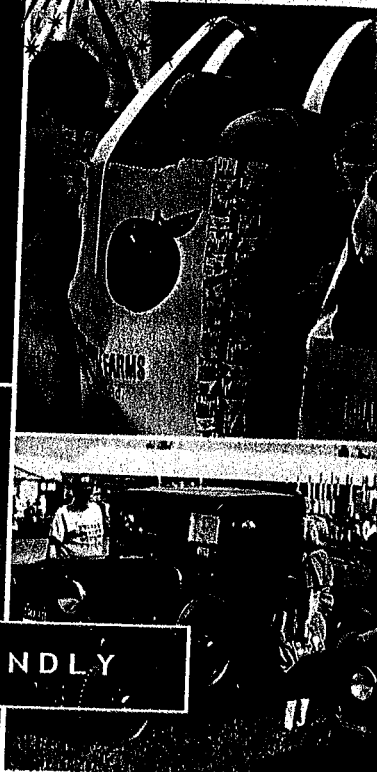

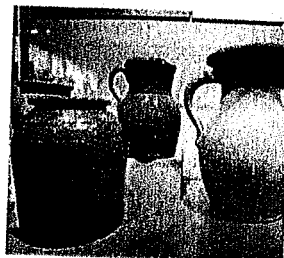


200 years ago, on March 24, 1820, the people of Stafford came together to incorporate their community as a town. First settled in 1798, it was one of the first towns in the Holland Purchase to be occupied.

The culture and architecture of Stafford was heavily influenced by an influx of immigrants from England who relied on a knowledge of farming to build a new life in the growing settlement. Today, farming is still the major business in the area, and many of the original homesteads are still inhabited 200 years later.

Enjoy a scenic drive through picturesque farmland while discovering this rich history—and our current-day community. Whether you're looking for a game of golf, a delicious meal, or a chance to explore the history and architecture of the area, Stafford has something to offer everyone!

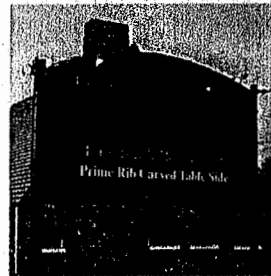
